- We are closed down and we will be doing Virtual Learning. District is currently building a plan and how everything is going to work.

- District will not renew any walk on coaches until we come back to school and they are physically there. This may affect Molica and Griselda who are vital to our Colorguard. Possibility of paying them hourly will still need to be determined. Also, we'll be trying to work on logistics.
- When school resumes, Band might be split into 3 groups.
- There are many questions but no answers for students and parents yet. Eventually we'll get more information.

- Mr. Phillips would like all previous staff to come back and help with Google meet.
- The National High School foundation is giving out a free field show along with choreography. It is mostly a Patriotic theme. Plans are to put together a show with the band in the fall and a parade march done in the Winter and play pep tunes in the stands.
- Will not be spending money on a show right now, on a season that doesn't exist and may not exist at all. Hopefully next year we can go full on.
- We will freeze any band fees until we put everything together.
- No curriculum change as far as band students receiving P.E. credit or Fine Arts credit.

NOTE from Leslie: We will not be sending Fairshare invoices out until we know what the status of the program is. We might have an emergency budget meeting to re-adjust things which we'll need to have sooner than November. Also, due to a new software Quickbooks Account upgrade, some band accounts may have received a pledge with your invoice for booster membership. If you had credit, it was automatically deducted from your credit. If you are new to the organization, please know this is how it will work from now on, we will pull from your credit first.
